These members represent the full spectrum of engineering disciplines; technicians, educators, as well as owners of businesses in engineering activities. Currently, the ESB supports 32 students in their scholarship program. The students are from the State University of New York at Buffalo, and Erie and Niagara County Community College.

Funds to support these scholarships are generated by direct contributions, income from investment of endowment funds and the annual scholarship run.

The Society employs two office administrators.

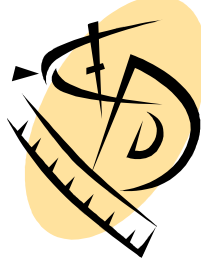
